

ICS COVID PROTOCOL:

The ICS does not obligate students to have a booster. The Spanish Government does obligate all students to be fully vaccinated before entry into Spain within 270 days before entrance.

When a student presents symptoms and tests positive on an antigen test, the ICS will put the following protocol in place:

The student will take an antigen test. The test is easily accessible at nearby pharmacies for approx. 3€.

If the antigen test comes out positive, the student must isolate until a negative result is obtained (usually 3 to 7 days). The student may isolate in their homestay. If this is not possible, the ICS will obtain alternative accommodations for the student and make sure their daily needs are met during their period of isolation. Likewise, students will be able to continue their coursework online during isolation.

While the ICS does not have a health center on campus, it does cover students under the Helvetia Health care plan for several of Seville's most prestigious private Hospitals as well as a large variety of specialists. One of these Hospitals, Clínica de Fatima, is 5 min walking from the ICS and has 24-hour urgent care. It also provides PCR and Antigen tests from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

If students need housing outside the programs date due to a positive Covid antigen test or for any other reason, they are responsible for the cost.
