

ABSOLUTELY ESSENTIAL


- passport
- student visa—most semester and year programs

HIGHLY RECOMMENDED

- positive attitudeeagerness to learn
- open-mindednessglobal awareness

BENEFITS OF STUDYING ABROAD

- Enroll in classes at an international institution and learn in a global setting.
- Travel with a group of fellow students and develop a unique bond with them.
- Seek the advice, counsel and mentorship of the Resident Director (faculty member who accompanies the students).
- Fulfill focus requirements (oral, writing intensive, ethics) from certain courses taught by the Resident Director.
- Earn UHM resident credits—not transfer credits.
- Learn the host culture and language from the inside, either by living with a host family or in a student dorm.
- Explore your adoptive city and country as your extended classroom.
- Apply UHM financial aid towards the cost of the program.
- Utilize scholarships as additional funding sources.
- Make yourself stand out as a citizen of the world.
- Earn UHM credits applicable toward your degree, including General Education and graduation requirements, which will enable a faster path to graduation.



PROGRAM COST

Cost includes host institution fees, housing, health insurance, meals, UHM Study Abroad and student visa fees, textbooks, and ground transportation. NOT included are roundtrip airfare and personal spending money.

Students have the option to take flights arranged by the UHM Study Abroad

Center or book their own travel itinerary.

REQUIREMENTS

- cumulative 3.0
 GPA; students who are slightly below 3.0 may be considered
- non-native English-speaking students must have taken the TOEFL exam with a minimum score of 600, or minimum score of 500 if through the English Language Institute
- successful completion of course prerequisites
- Study Abroad Center application, including letters of recommendation
- application fee: \$30

Study abroad programs are designed for sophomore-, junior-, or senior-level undergraduate students. Admission to the program is selective. All applicants for the program will be judged on their academic performance, reasons for wishing to attend the program, flexibility and sensitivity to other cultures, and ability to adjust to a new cultural setting.

A complete application consists of:

- general student information
- study statement
- confidential academic references
- student progress report (first-year college students only)
- transcripts
- \$30 application fee

Applications must be submitted directly to the UHM Study Abroad Center by the following deadlines to receive consideration:

Immediately upon acceptance to the program, students are required to pay a non-refundable initial payment* to ensure their place in the program. The initial payment will be applied toward the cost of the program. Students are also required to attend 12 hours of mandatory cross-cultural pre-departure class sessions.
